

Activity: Speaking about Culture

Aims of the tool:

The main objective of this activity is to be able to speak about the signs of different cultures in reality and to connect the outcomes of the day with the reality.

Materials needed:

We just need a place to discuss about the questions and the concepts we introduce.

Time: 90 min

Description:

1. We divide participants into groups (4 members in a group). Each group needs to find and play out at least 3 stereotypes of the other present country on the event.
2. Playing out the stereotypes.
3. Debriefing:
 - What do you like from other cultures?
 - What don't you like from other cultures?

- How do you deal with the things you do not like?
- What would you need in order to react differently?
- What do you think would support different cultures in living together?

4. Reflection: five fingers reflection:

- What did you like?
- What would you like to point out?
- What you did not like?
- What are you taking with you?
- Would you like to say anything to the trainers? What?
